**ORDER DENYING MOTION TO  
RECONSIDER AND EXTENDING  
PRELIMINARY INJUNCTION  
[Dkt. 29]**

Defendant Cardiff School District filed an Application for Leave to File a Motion to Reconsider the Court’s July 24, 2020 Amended Order of Preliminary Injunction. Dkt. 29. The District argued, among other things, that the Amended Order was insufficiently deferential to Defendant National Park Service’s (“NPS”) approval of the District’s project and that the public had a strong interest in continued


1 construction once it appeared likely that the District would be able to open schools  
2 for in-person learning in September.

3 NPS has rescinded its approval of the project at issue here. Dkt. 44. Since NPS's  
4 action no longer conflicts with the Amended Order, the question of the Court's  
5 deference to NPS is moot. Moreover, that rescission confirms that the interests at  
6 stake are best served by an injunction. While the local public has an interest in  
7 opening Cardiff School in time for in-person instruction, the broader public has a  
8 countervailing interest in ensuring compliance with federal laws and regulations. In  
9 the absence of NPS approval, the latter interest is substantially stronger.

10 The Motion to Reconsider is **DENIED**. The Preliminary Injunction will remain  
11 in effect until the Court orders otherwise.
