

Policy 5117: Interdistrict Attendance

The Governing Board recognizes that parents/guardians who reside within the geographic boundaries of one district may, for a variety of reasons, desire to enroll their children in another district and that such choices are made for a variety of reasons. The Board desires to communicate with parents/guardians and students regarding the educational programs and services that are available.

Students residing outside the boundaries of the district may, in limited circumstances, be permitted to attend schools in the district through approval of an interdistrict Attendance Agreement/Permit. The interdistrict Attendance agreement/permit is governed by laws and procedures, as described in this policy and its related administrative regulation (AR 5117).

Interdistrict Attendance Agreements

A student's parent/guardian may seek an interdistrict transfer based on an interdistrict Transfer Agreement and Permit. (Education Code 46600 et seq.) The district will accept interdistrict transfers based on interdistrict Transfer Agreements only in limited circumstances. The district shall not accept transfer requests pursuant to an interdistrict Attendance Agreement except (1) in situations of extreme need, (2) for children of certain employees of the district, as specified by administrative regulation AR 5117, and (3) for students who move out of the district on or after April 1, for the limited purpose of allowing the student to complete that school year in the district. Parents/guardians of a student attending a school in another district on the Open Enrollment List shall be subject to the transfer application process.
