

Policy 6154: Homework/Makeup Work

Status: ADOPTED

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The Governing Board recognizes that good homework practices are consistent with good teaching. Homework should be assigned not simply as a matter of routine, but only when there is clear purpose in regard to student learning.

The Superintendent or designee shall ensure that administrators and teachers develop and implement an effective homework plan at each school site. As needed, teachers may receive training about the purpose and effectiveness of homework based on current research, and in the design of meaningful homework assignments that reinforce classroom learning objectives.

Makeup Work

Students who miss schoolwork because of an absence shall be given the opportunity to complete all assignments and tests that can be reasonably provided. As determined by the teacher, the assignments and tests shall be reasonably equivalent to, but not necessarily identical to, the assignments and tests missed during the absence. Students shall receive full credit for work satisfactorily completed within a reasonable period of time. (Education Code 48205)
